How Do I Know If I Qualify For Social Security Disability?

You need to meet the Social Security Disability earnings requirement in order to qualify. This means that you must have worked approximately 5 out of the last 10 years at a job where you were actively paying into Social Security.

2. You Must Have a Medical Condition That Meets Social Security's Definition of a Disability.

In order to qualify for Social Security Disability, you need to have a

medical impairment that will last 12 consecutive months or result in death. This injury must prevent you from returning to work.

If you qualify for Social Security Disability, it is important that you take the time to fully understand the compensation that you are entitled to and the options that are available to you.
