Why are Workers' Compensation Hearings Scheduled?

Workers' compensation is a form of insurance that is supposed to pay you a percentage of your lost salary while you are out of work.

If your insurance company wants to dispute your claim for benefits, a workers' compensation hearing is scheduled to assess the case.

What Happens at a Workers' Compensation Hearing?

Workers' compensation hearings typically happen quickly. There will be an attorney representing the interests of the insurance company at the hearing. At the hearing, the judge will preside and decide if you are entitled to receive workers' compensation benefits and the amount of those benefits.

Unfortunately, judges don't often have enough time to explain all of the nuances of the law. It's important that you have an attorney sitting with you at the hearing, too. This will ensure that your case is properly assessed and that you receive the maximum award that you are entitled to under the law.
